QUICK FACTS

PINOCHIO has consistent high yields. In official Danish trials Pinocchio out-yielded Nitouche by 3% to confirm its position as one of the top varieties. In the official PGRO trials in the UK, Pinocchio exhibited excellent standing power finishing as the best variety for standability. It also has very good disease resistance which is crucial in low impact crops. Pinocchio is a relatively tall variety (36 cm high at harvest) which provides for easy combining, less soil ingress, and reduced waste. Pinocchio peas are 100% organic.



ADAPTATION

PINOCHIO is well suited for grain production where the peas will be used as a protein supplement for livestock. It's also useful as a cover crop for plow down. Pinocchio is most commonly used in combination with small grains as an annual forage crop. It will provide high protein forage with high yields.
